

Basic regulations for adding artists to the INTERNATIONAL CLUB SCENE playlist

- 1. Only artists whose genre corresponds to the METAL HEART RADIO's musical focus may be included in the playlist thus performers who play all of the subgenres of Metal, possibly Hard Rock. Other musical genres are not allowed to be in the playlist.
- 2. A maximum of 2 songs are concurrently included in each broadcast for every artist. If the artist sends more songs at once, it is on the arrangement of the artist and editor whether and when will be the 2 chosen ones included to the playlist.
- 3. Each artist is included in the playlist for 2 months, then at least 1 month out of the playlist. He can be returned to the broadcast for another 2 months at any time if he is still interested afterwards but he does not decide if we will broadcast the original or the newly received songs.
- 4. The songs are included in the playlist always by the 1st and the 15th day of the current month. The artist has to send the songs at least 3 days before the date if he wants them to be included in the playlist. In case of failure meeting the deadline will the songs be included in the following term if it is capacitatively possible.
- 5. The condition for the inclusion to the playlist is the delivery of the songs in MP3 format (Not WAW or any other format). The recommended/required bitrate is 320 kbps (Lower bitrate degrades the quality of broadcasted song).
- 6. It is not important in which language the lyrics are written.
- 7. Songs whose lyrics are contrary to the laws of the Czech Republic will not be included in the playlist. The band (authors) is fully responsible for the lyrical content of the song. METAL HEART radio not at all.
- 8. The editorials reserves the general right whether the song or the artist will be included to the playlist or not.
- 9. The editorials reserves the right postpone the inclusion of the artist or the songs to a term when will the playlist be able to be filled with new tracks.
- 10. We recommend to the bands to tell us (in case of sending more songs) which ones they prefer for the inclusion to the playlist. Since we do not have the capacity to listen to whole albums and the artist will not give us their recommendations the tracks will be selected randomly.

If the artist decides to add greeting to the <u>audience for their song</u>, it has to be sent in MP3 and the same bitrate that corresponds to the bitrate of the song. A **maximum lenght** of the greeting is **15 seconds**.

Send the tracks only in the form of transfer services where it will be downloadable for at least 7 days. There is also the opportunity of sending it in the form of a service download link Dropbox, Google disc, and so on.

Do not send the tracks by e-mail.
